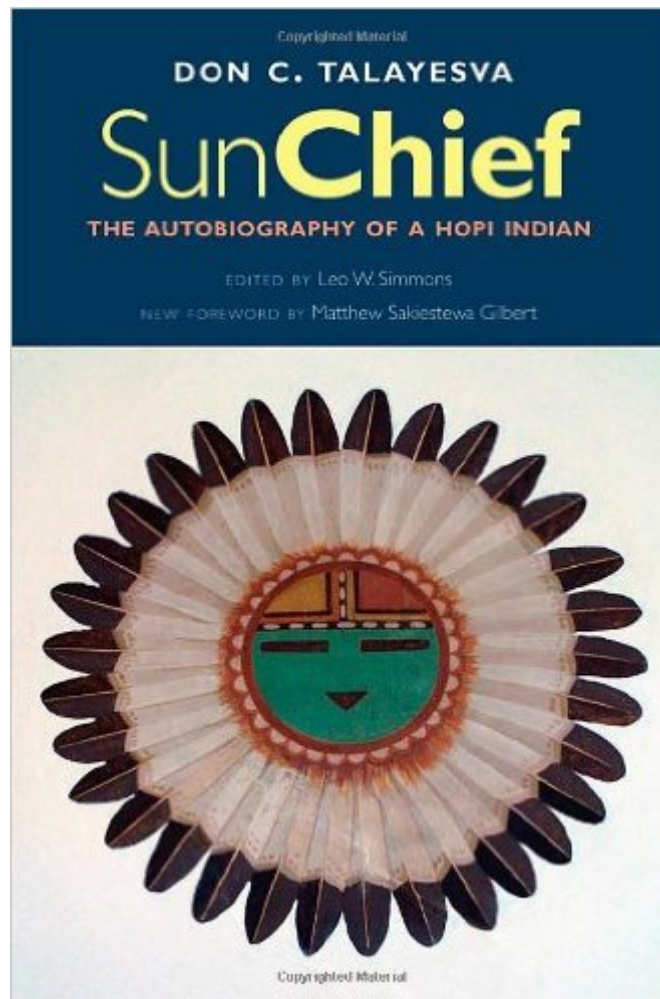


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Sun Chief: The Autobiography Of A Hopi Indian, Second Edition (The Lamar Series In Western History)
